Forwarded herewith for the approval of the State Civil Service Commission is a classification resolution which has been approved by me and the Mayor to amend the classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York in the Non-Competitive Class, Part I, by classifying the above titles in the Non-Competitive Class.

A public hearing was held on April 6, 2009 to consider this proposal, and the record was held open for written submissions until April 10, 2009.

As part of the DCAS Five-Year Plan to reduce the number of provisional employees serving, we proposed a number of classification action to reclassify certain competitive class titles to the non-competitive class. This is one such action.

In addition to the classification resolution for commission approval, enclosed for your information are the following: the transcript of the public hearing and written submissions; DCAS public hearing summary and statement in support of the proposal, which includes attachments showing the current titles and numbers of incumbents in each title and City agency; and the class specifications for the 12 titles.

I recommend that you approve this resolution. Once the resolution is approved, it should be filed with the Secretary of State and returned to the Department of Citywide Administrative Services.
