## <u>NOTE</u>: CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS STATED BELOW AND, IN THE ANNOUNCEMENT, AT THE TIME OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION, AT THE TIME OF APPOINTMENT, AND AT APPROPRIATE INTERVALS THEREAFTER.

- 1. <u>Weight</u> Weight must not interfere with ability to perform the duties of the position.
- 2. <u>Vision</u> Candidates must have binocular vision not less than 20/40 with or without correction. Binocular peripheral vision should not be less than 150 degrees.
- 3. <u>Hearing</u> Candidates must be able to pass an audiometric test of hearing acuity. A binaural hearing loss of greater than 15% in the frequency ranges of 500, 1000, 2000 Hz would be considered disqualifying. Hearing appliances should correct the deficiency so the binaural hearing loss in the combined frequency level of 500, 1000 and 2000 Hz is no greater than 15%.
- 4. <u>Heart</u> Candidates must be free of functionally limiting heart disease. Must have a functional cardiac classification of no greater than Class I. This determination to be made clinically or by cardiac stress test.
- 5. <u>Lungs</u> The respiratory system must be free of chronic disabling conditions that would interfere with the candidate's performance of required duties including the use of a respirator. A test of pulmonary function will be conducted as a base line study and a respirator fitness evaluation will be conducted.
- 6. <u>Diabetes</u> Candidates who are diabetic must provide evidence of satisfactory medical control.
- 7. <u>Neurological Health</u> Candidates must be free of neurological disorders that may affect job performance. Candidates with any type of epilepsy or seizure disorders must provide evidence of one-year seizure free history with or without medication.
- 8. <u>Musculoskeletal Health</u> Candidates must be free of musculoskeletal defects, deformities or disorders which may affect job performance. Functional use of the arms, hands, legs, feet and back must be demonstrable at the examination. The examining physician will test agility and flexibility.
- 9. Hernia Candidate must be free of abdominal, inguinal or femoral hernia which would interfere with job performance.
- 10. <u>Blood-Vascular Health</u> Candidates must be free of blood or vascular disorders that interfere with the performance of duties. Candidates with uncontrolled high blood pressure will be disqualified remediable.
- 11. <u>Mental Health</u> Candidates must be free of mental illness, serious emotional disturbances or nervous disorders, including claustrophobia, acrophobia, active alcoholism, drug dependence or abuse that would interfere with the performance of their duties. Evaluations in these cases will be done on an individual basis.

<u>General Medical Statement</u> - Candidates must be free of any medical and/or nervous condition which would jeopardize safety and health of the public and/or other individuals.

CANDIDATES WHO ARE EXAMINED WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A MEDICAL LABORATORY FEE. THE APPOINTING AGENCY WILL REQUEST IONIZING RADIATION DOSIMETRY HISTORY TO DETERMINE CANDIDATES SUITABILITY TO PERFORM THE ESSENTIAL DUTIES OF THE POSITION.
