**1. MUNICIPAL SERVICE**

- 1.53 (A) CITY OF MOUNT VERNON CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION. Conference regarding the follow-up on the Merit System Administration Report for the City of Mount Vernon Civil Service Commission.

**The State Commission met with members of the City Civil Service Commission to discuss the lack of progress made in recent months in addressing the remaining nine recommendations cited in the 2008 Merit System Administration Report, and acknowledged the efforts taken by the City Commission and the difficulties in gaining compliance from civil divisions under its jurisdiction. Continued efforts are imperative to ensure appropriate merit system administration in the City. Due to the fact that the City Commission's latest submission to document its progress was provided the day before the conference, the State Commission directed staff to review the documentation provided and advise the Commission at its September meeting of the status of the progress. The State Commission also expects the City Commission to immediately provide a copy of the certified payroll , and to continue discussions with staff to appropriately adopt a resolution to amend the Text and Appendices of the Mount Vernon Rules, as well as address the remaining recommendations.**

**The State Commission reviewed the fifth progress report from the Long Beach Civil Service Commission, and found that one required action has been resolved; twenty-two required actions remain unresolved. The State Commission noted the efforts made by the City Commission in making progress in addressing the remaining required actions, but also indicated that the remaining required actions are essential to determining the status of employees and are imperative to effective merit system administration. Therefore, the State Commission directed that the City Commission:**

- **Provide updated certified payrolls for the School District and City no later than August 15, 2011, as the previous certification expired July 15, 2011;**
- **Submit the certified payroll for the Library and Housing Authority no later than September 15, 2011, as the timeline provided indicates they will be certified by the end of August 2011;**
- **Provide a full and complete progress report no later than September 15, 2011.**

**Further, the State Commission stated that dependent on the progress made in certifying the payrolls for civil divisions under the City's jurisdiction, the State Commission may still direct the City to attend a conference to discuss the progress made.**
