The State Commission disapproved the proposed amendments to the Appendices based on the fact that the City Commission was non-responsive to staff's request for additional information in order to process the resolutions. The State Commission noted that staff had reached out to the City Commission on at least three different occasions to obtain this information, and provided the City Commission a complete walk-through of the information required during staff's February on-site visit. In order for the resolutions to be fully reviewed and a complete analysis undertaken, this information must be provided.

The State Commission approved the proposed amendments to the Text changes, as the proposed amendments were consistent with the *Model Rules* or previous State Commission determinations, with the following exceptions. These disapprovals were based on the fact that no justification for the proposed amendments were provided, and the City Commission was non-responsive to staff's request for information:

- **Rule XV – Trainee and Temporary Appointments – Section 2**

If awards are approved as recommended by the Suggestion Program staff, the cash awards granted will amount to \$365.00, of which \$225.00 will be paid by the Department of Civil Service.

- 6.17 *Suggestion No. 401242* – from the Department of Taxation and Finance (DTF) for Monica DeVito, a Grade 14 Taxpayer Services Specialist 1 who proposed revising the Notice of Adjusted Refund regarding dependent care tax credit notification, to include the information the taxpayer needs to provide in order to claim denied credits. This suggestion was implemented May 16, 2012. The suggestion committee for the DTF reported that a paragraph was added to the taxpayers adjusted refund notification informing them what information they needed to provide in order to claim the denied credits. This suggestion resulted in a reduction in calls received by the Protest Resolution Bureau. The Committee determined the suggestion was not job related and recommended an intangible award of \$75 and a certificate of merit.

- 6.18 *Suggestion No. 408708* – from the Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) for Gary Wager, a Grade 9 Calculations Clerk 2 who proposed creating a recycling program for certain office supplies by having each WCB location ship empty tonners and related items directly to the IKON recycling facility in shipping boxes provided by IKON at no cost. The Board's regional offices and service centers had been shipping them to the Menands location for recycling pick up which had mailing costs associated with sending them to the one location for return. This suggestion was implemented April 5, 2011. The suggestion committee for WCB reported that this suggestion eliminated shipping costs and multiple handling and storage issues. The Committee indicated the Menands location received approximately 30 empty toner cartridges a month, each weighing between 4 to 7 pounds and calculated shipping costs to be approximately \$200 a month for annual savings of \$2400. The Committee determined the suggestion was not job related and recommended a tangible award of \$240 (10% of the first years savings) and a certificate of merit.

Suggestion No. 420093 – from the Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) for Barbara James, a Grade 9 Assistant Workers' Compensation Examiner who proposed having a designated section added to the last page of the Board's Application for a Fee by Claimant's Attorney or Representative (Form OC-400.1) that would provide for the WCB's case number. This suggestion was implemented May 21, 2012. The suggestion committee for WCB reported that prior to this suggestion, staff had been instructed to insert the case number on all pages of the document manually and that implementation enhanced the procedural process. The Committee determined the suggestion was not job related and recommended an intangible award of \$50 and a certificate of merit.
