The Commission also disapproved non-competitive jurisdictional classification of the title Building and Land Use Officer (Village of Tuxedo Park) under the header 'In the Village of Tuxedo Park (under 5000 population).

This resolution initially contained forty (40) proposals to amend the Appendices of the Rockland County Civil Service Rules (22 additions and 18 deletions). Twenty (20) of the proposals (10 additions and 10 deletions) were considered by the Commission at its meeting of March 10, 2021.

Subsequent to the March 2021 meeting, the Rockland County Commissioner of Personnel withdrew her request to add the title Labor Relations Administrators to the non-competitive class with a phi designation. The Commissioner of Personnel also withdrew the request to delete the singular title Labor Relations Administrator from the non-competitive class of its Appendices – this title had been approved by the Commission with a phi designation.

At this meeting, the Commission considered the remaining eighteen (18) of the proposed amendments to the Appendices (11 additions and 7 deletions).

The Commission disapproved non-competitive jurisdictional classification of the title Supervising Housekeepers under the header ‘In any Department or Office where the positions are established.’ The Commission also disapproved non-competitive jurisdictional classification with the policy-influencing/confidential designation for the title of Special Assistant to the Rockland Water Task Force on Water Resources Management in the Department of Health.
