- 6.1 ***Suggestion No. 432220*** – from the Department of Taxation and Finance (T&F) for Brian Lamphere, a Grade 11 Tax Compliance Representative who proposed an online garnishment calculator be implemented to help employers determine how much money to remit when calculating a second service income execution for their employees. This suggestion was implemented January 1, 2015. The suggestion committee for T&F reported the application was successfully accessed approximately 6,000 times, of which 1,600 reached the payment calculation page. The committee determined the suggestion was job related however indicated the expense to implement it was minimal and the improvement streamlined the process for employers, greatly enhancing customer service. Accordingly, the committee recommended an intangible award of \$100 and a Certificate of Merit.
