- 6.5            ***Suggestion No. 458125*** - from the Department of Motor Vehicles (MV's) for Robert Mielenz, a Grade 9 Office Assistant 2 (Customer Service) who proposed streamlining the agency's standard traffic ticket processing procedure by eliminating the automated notice of hearing sent to out of state motorists since the majority of them requested to submit an affidavit in lieu of coming to New York State for a ticket plea which, in turn, generated the need for subsequent mailings. The suggestion committee for MV's reported the suggestion was implemented on August 1, 2014, was not job related and amounted to a cost savings in postage, envelopes, sorting and insertions totaling \$24,588.25 in the first year. The MV's suggestion committee is recommending a tangible award of \$2,458.83 (10% of the first years savings) and a Certificate of Merit.
