- 1.59 (A) BROOME COUNTY PERSONNEL OFFICER. Request for Commission approval of the resolution amending the Appendices of the Broome County Civil Service Rules. ([View Resolution](#))

Approved with the following exceptions:

In the Town of Union – The State Commission calendared the request to place the Commissioner of Public Works in the unclassified service, and the Deputy Commissioner of Public Works – Codes and Ordinances, Deputy Commissioner of Public Works – Engineering, Deputy Commissioner of Public Works – Recreation, and Deputy Commissioner of Public Works – Environmental Service in the exempt class, for clarification from Department Counsel regarding the application of the size and significance standard, and information regarding reporting relationships in the department.

In the Village of Deposit – The State Commission disapproved the request to place Deputy Village Clerk-Treasurer in the exempt class for a request that includes the adoption of a local law authorizing the Deputy to act for and in place of the Village Clerk-Treasurer.

In the Village of Deposit – The State Commission disapproved without prejudice the request to place the Superintendent of Public Works in the unclassified service based on the size of the department and requirements of the position, for a submission to place the position in the non-competitive class (designated policy influencing/confidential) that includes clarification on the department budget and confirmation on the number of employees in the department.

- 1.60 (B) TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION. Request for Commission approval of the resolution amending the Appendices of the Town of Hempstead Civil Service Rules. ([View Resolution](#))

The State Commission disapproved the request to place the Director of Emergency Preparedness (PT) in the Lewis County General Hospital in the non-competitive class based on the practicability of competitive examination and lack of compelling evidence. The State Commission was concerned about the recruitment methods used by the County, and recommended expanding recruitment efforts to capture a larger candidate pool. There was also concern regarding the fact that the provisional incumbent has been unsuccessful on the examination.

The State Commission recognized the progress made by DCAS in reducing provisional appointments during the six months ending May 31, 2012, but noted that DCAS has missed its overall provisional reduction goal established for this point in the Plan. The State Commission also directed Commission staff to continue discussions with DCAS staff regarding the status of a revised Plan and request for a one-year extension of the Plan, which DCAS indicated it intends to submit.
