The November 2009 version includes information about Medicare Advantage plans, Part B reimbursement and Medicare and NYSHIP claims coordination.

If you place an order online for the New Retiree Quick Order package, the book is included. Five months prior to an enrollee's 65th birthday, a letter will be sent from the Department to remind them that they must enroll in Medicare before their 65th birthday. We will send you a supply equal to 2 percent of your enrollment to distribute to your Empire Plan enrollees.
