Dear Enrollee,

As an enrollee in the New York State Health Insurance Program (NYSHIP), you are probably aware that New York State pays a portion of the premium for your health insurance coverage and that your portion of the premium is taken via payroll deduction. Your percentage of the total cost for health insurance premium is based upon your salary grade as shown in the table below:

NYSHIP recently received notice from your personnel office that your salary grade was updated and results in a change to the premium percentage you are required to pay. Therefore, the amount deducted from your payroll check will also change. Your previous biweekly deduction was \$<<>>. Your new deduction will be \$<<>>.

Based upon the effective date of your salary grade change, you may also be subject to retroactive health insurance premium adjustments. These are collected through special deductions or, if applicable, refunded through your biweekly paycheck.
