We are pleased to announce that the 2020 Annual Participating Employer Webinar will be held Thursday, December 3, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The Employee Benefits Division will present information on New York State Health Insurance Program (NYSHIP) updates related to policies, Health Benefits Administrators' (HBAs') responsibilities, and benefit changes.

This year, it will be **mandatory** for all Participating Employer (PE) HBA's to either attend the live 2020 Annual NYSHIP Participating Employer Webinar or to watch a recording of the webinar.

There is a limit to the number of registrants allowed.
