## HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Interested students use an internship portal to view job descriptions, review and identify preferred internships, submit applications, and upload resumes
- Available internships can be filtered by degree concentration, occupational interest, location, and state agency
- Students may apply for multiple internship opportunities with one application
- Each host office or agency reviews applications, conducts interviews, and offers student intern positions to selected candidates
- Appointments are made on an ongoing basis
