 - Univera Healthcare HMO: Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie, Genesee, Niagara, Orleans and Wyoming Counties.
- Excellus Health Plan, Inc. is approved to serve the Medicaid and Health and Recovery Plan (HARP) eligible Medicaid populations in the counties of Broome, Erie, Herkimer, Livingston, Monroe, Oneida, Ontario, Orleans, Otsego, Seneca, Wayne, and Yates. The provision of health care services in these counties is contingent upon execution of the Medicaid contract with New York State.
- Excellus Health Plan, Inc. is approved to serve the Child Health Plus population in the counties of Broome, Cayuga, Chemung, Chenango, Clinton, Cortland, Delaware, Erie, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Monroe, Montgomery, Oneida, Onondaga, Ontario, Orleans, Oswego, Otsego, Schuyler, Seneca, Steuben, St. Lawrence, Tioga, Tompkins, Wayne and Yates. All aspects of operation in the Medicare only counties will be governed primarily by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and implementation is contingent upon securing a Medicare contract with the Federal government.
